

Parents-day out programs (PDOs) have been exempt from the licensure law and regulations since 1976. The law (TCA 71-3-527a) states that:

The provisions of this part (Chapter 3 part 5) shall not apply to "Parents Day Out" or similar programs carried on by churches or church organizations which provide custodial care and services for children of less than school age for not more than two (2) days in each calendar week and for not more than six (6) hours each day, and the conducting of any such program shall not be construed to constitute the operation of a child care center.

I understand that the Parents' Day Out Program at Brentwood Young Children's School is not licensed and is not required to be licensed by the State of Tennessee Department of Human Services.
